Brush or spray application: To make 8 oz., blend 5 oz. Graining Liquid, 2.5 oz. Ultra Penetrating Stain Retarder or Blush Resistant Reducer and 1 oz. Bronzing Powder. Bronzing Powder may be added to glazes as needed to make a metallic glaze and also into lacquer for a metallic coating, however they must be used within 1-2 hours as they may become unstable and turn the coating thick and green in color.
