

Beyond The Surface

Orange Oil Application Instructions from Howard Products

Spray Howard Orange Oil or Lemon Oil on a soft cloth and wipe on the wood surface. Polish to a luster with a clean, soft cloth.

For some applications, it can be sprayed directly onto the wood surface. However, test first by applying with a soft cloth to check compatibility.

For example: an unfinished or natural oak wood surface may absorb more Orange Oil than a finished surface, so it might be best to spray directly onto the wood. Then allow the product to penetrate and buff in five minutes to remove any excess. <u>Feed-N-Wax</u> also looks fantastic on natural wood surfaces. On finished wood surfaces, Orange Oil should be sprayed directly onto a soft cloth then applied with that same soft cloth to the finished wood surface.

Precautions

Always test on a small inconspicuous area on the wood to check compatibility with the wood finish. Use caution when using on floors as surface may become slippery.
